**9.15am Contemporary Service** - led by Fiona Budd

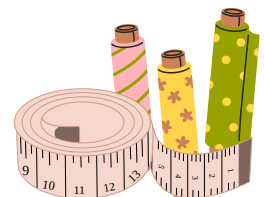

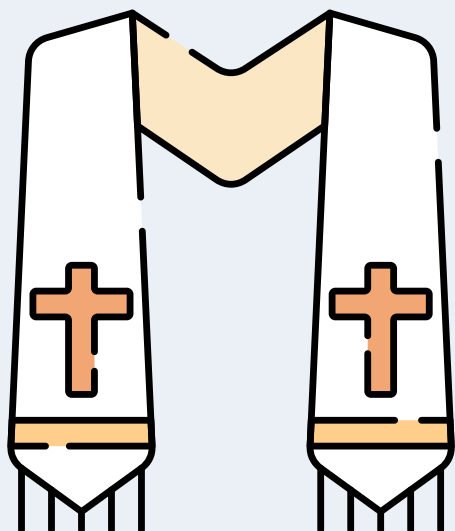
