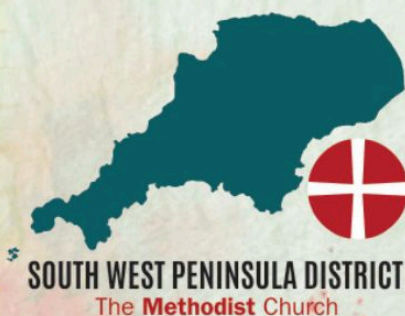


Let's face it!
