A Delightful Afternoon!

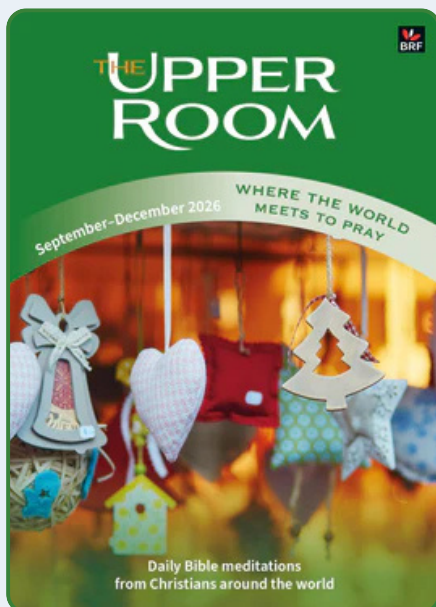

Update on free Food Safety and L3 Emergency First Aid courses

I'm pleased to report that the first cohort of 10 students have now been enrolled onto an on-line L2 Food Safety course, run by the Training at Work group. Hopefully this will work out well and I am continuing to compile a list of others interested in signing-up so we can make up a further group of 10. The course comprises 10 modules with a short test at the end of each (which can be taken as many times as required). On registration, students have a whole year in which to complete it, so there is absolutely no time pressure.

L3 Emergency First Aid course

I have sourced First Training, a company based in Saltash who offer in-person training - this will be a 6 hour course, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm, to be held either at Wesley or at the HQ of the company, depending on numbers. I have currently nine names on my list - First Training can only accommodate 8 on their premises, but if we can find a suitable date and availability for either the Sports Hall or Small Hall at Wesley, they could teach a group of 12 here.
